Compulsory REVISION comments	When the rashes disappeared following the once in 3days 250mg HU dose, the authors should have demonstrated the effect of this dose and frequency on the haemoglobin profile of the patient. Can we prove this dosage/frequency increased the level of HbF?	She has been on the hydroxyurea continuously for about 10months now without any episode of painful crisis since re-commencement of HU. This is against the period preceding hydroxyurea use. Frequency of bone pain crisis reduced significantly, this is as a result of increased fetal haemoglobin as shown in Table III
