Every reference referred in the text must also present in the reference list and vice versa. In the text, citations should be indicated by the reference number in brackets [3] before punctuation. • References are not up to date. • Number of references for case report should not exceed 20. • Reference numbers 6,8,10,11,12,16,17 &18 in the references list are missing in text citations. • References list should be in Vancouver style.
