<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>The work done is interesting, well presented, and in general, presents a good originality and proposal both methodological and practical. However, I believe that there are some aspects that should be resolved before they can be published:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The introduction includes quite a few references to related work that should be moved, in an orderly and effective way, to section 2, which suffers from a complete systematic review of solutions similar to the one proposed by the authors. In general, I believe that this systematic review of other similar proposals should also be used as a common thread in the evaluation, comparing the results in specific scenarios obtained by the authors' proposal and others existing in the market and in the more academic world.</li> <li>- The evaluation should include a much more detailed description of the sample to be studied, with its descriptive characteristics.</li> <li>- It would include a discussion section on the threats to the validation carried out (internal, external threats, etc.) in order to increase the validity of this section.</li> <li>- The conclusions are too brief. I think the authors can improve this part.</li> </ul>
