I rather think that the barber shops in question are not "barber chops"! It is still not clear that "ensured to disinfect the perimeter inside the barber's chop in order to prevent contamination" how was performed (disinfecting the floor before the hair was dropped?). As far as I have spent several years working in Africa, I'm fully aware of the problems of such sampling and the hygienic conditions in a barber "chop".</p>	<p>Thank you for your insightful review sir.
